
A gentle reminder to print the entire page as its original A4 size for the most accurate result.

Method One: Measuring with an existing ring


- 1. Find a ring that matches the size of your finger.
- 2. Place your ring on this page and note the circle with the closest size.
- 3. Make sure the inside of your ring aligns with the outer edge of the circle as much as possible.
- 4. If your ring sits between two sizes or if you are not sure about your measurement, you are welcomed to visit our store and our team will be happy to take your measurements for you.





Method Two: DIY measuring guide

- 1. Use a scissor to cut out the following measuring guide.
- 2. Create a vertical slit as marked by the thick white guideline.
- 3. Wrap the measuring guide around your finer that you plan to wear your ring.
- 4. Pull until the measuring guide wraps your finger tightly.
- 5. Read the number labeled on the measuring guide.
- 6. Convert the finger measuring you got into the inner diameter of your bracelet with the following conversion table.

- 5. The actual sizes of rings may vary slightly due to differences in design.
